



OFFICIAL CALL

Mass Meeting of the King George Republican Committee Of the Republican Party of Virginia

As Chairman of the King George Republican Committee of the Republican Party of Virginia, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, Ron McElrath, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held at the L.E. Smoot Memorial Library, 9533 Kings Hwy, King George, VA 22485, on April 12th, 2018 (check in to begin at 6:30 PM) starting at 7:00 PM for the following purposes:

1. Electing a Unit Chairman
2. Electing members of the Unit Committee

I. Qualifications for Participation All legal and qualified voters of King George County, under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts. In addition to the foregoing, to be in accord with the principles of the Republican Party, a person otherwise qualified hereunder shall not have participated in Virginia in the nomination process of a party other than the Republican Party in the last five years.

A single exception to the above shall be approved for a voter that renounces affiliation with any other party in writing, and who expresses in writing that he/she is in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and intends, at the time of the writing, to support the nominees of the Republican Party in the future. A voter that utilizes the foregoing exception, and thereafter participates in the nomination process of a Party other than the Republican Party, shall not have the benefit of the exception as identified in this paragraph thereafter. In order to be eligible for election as a Delegate or Alternate Delegate to any convention, an individual must be registered to vote no later than the pre-filing deadline established by the Official Committee. A person who has made application for registration and meets all other requirements herein, but whose name does not appear on the local registration books solely because of the books having been closed in connection with a local election, will nevertheless be deemed a legal and qualified voter.

II. Filing Requirements:

1. Candidates for the election of a unit chairman shall file the form attached to this Call, with a registration fee of \$100.00 (non-refundable and payable to the King George Committee) to KGRC, PO Box 221, King George, VA 22485 or in person to any Officer of the King George Republican Committee and must be received not later than April 6th, 2018 at 5:00pm. Postmarks do not govern. If only one candidate properly files, then said candidate shall be declared the chairman.

2. Candidates for the election to unit member shall file the form attached to this Call, with biennial dues of \$40.00 (non-refundable and payable to the King George Committee) to KGRC, PO Box 221, King George, VA 22485 or in person to any Officer of the King George Republican Committee and must be received not later than April 6th, 2018 at 5:00 PM. Postmarks do not govern.

No nominations will be accepted from the floor. No resolutions will be accepted from the floor.

If the number of Candidates for membership in the King George Republican Committee that have properly filed in accordance with this call does not exceed that number allotted by the State Party Plan AND there is only one candidate properly filed in accordance with this call for Unit Chairman then, at the sole discretion of the Unit Chair, this Mass Meeting may be cancelled.
