



OFFICIAL CALL
Mass Meeting
King William County Committee
of the Republican Party of Virginia

As Chairman of the King William County Committee of the Republican Party of Virginia, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, Cecil Schools, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held at the Pamunkey Regional Library-Upper King William Branch, 694-J Sharon Road, King William, VA 23086 at 5:00 p.m. local time on Monday, September 10, 2018 for the following purposes:

1. Electing a Unit Chairman for the King William County Republican Committee;
2. Electing Members of the King William County Republican Committee; and
3. For the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the Mass Meeting.

Qualifications for Participation

All legal and qualified voters of King William County, under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts. In addition to the foregoing, to be in accord with the principles of the Republican Party, a person otherwise qualified hereunder shall not have participated in Virginia in the nomination process of a party other than the Republican Party in the last five years. A single exception to the above shall be approved for a voter that renounces affiliation with any other party in writing, and who expresses in writing that he/she is in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and intends, at the time of the writing, to support the nominees of the Republican Party in the future. A voter that utilizes the foregoing exception, and thereafter participates in the nomination process of a Party other than the Republican Party, shall not have the benefit of the exception as identified in this paragraph thereafter.

Filing Requirements

Candidates for election to the position of Unit Chairman or Committee Member of the King William County Republican Committee (KWCRC) shall file a written statement of intent to seek election. The statement must identify the office sought and include the candidate's name, address, and phone number, signature, and, if the candidate has one, an email address. All statements must be received no later than 5:00 p.m. on September 9, 2018 by the KWCRC Secretary, John Breeden, 325 Walnut Lane, King William, Virginia 23086. Postmarks do not govern.

Pre-file forms are attached to this Call and are also available on the Call posted on the Republican Party of Virginia website, www.rpv.org and the 1st Congressional District website, va01republicans.org Forms are also available by calling John Breeden at 804-338-6384.

No nominations will be accepted from the floor. No resolutions will be accepted from the floor. If the number of Candidates for membership in the King William County Republican Committee that have properly filed in accordance with this call does not exceed that number allotted by the State Party Plan AND there is only one candidate properly filed in accordance with this call for Unit Chairman, they will be deemed elected and the Mass Meeting will be cancelled.
